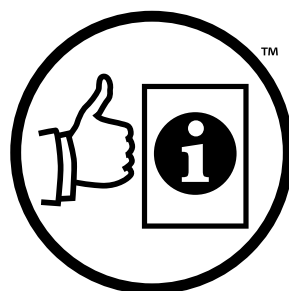

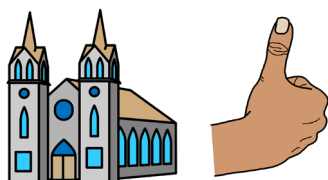

Sexual abuse means sexual activity a person does **not** want including

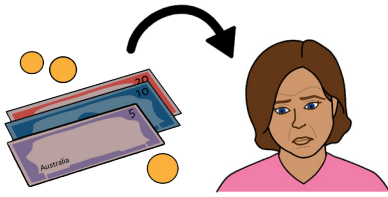
- touching you do **not** want

- sex you do **not** want.



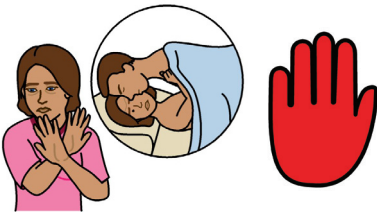
Victims are the people who were abused.

- work with Church leaders to work out how to stop abuse in the future



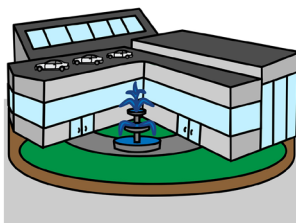
- make teams of experts who can help victims and help leaders support victims



- say sorry to victims and families hurt by the Church in Australia

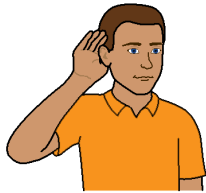


- have Church events for victims to meet

- use the internet to connect with people and hear more ideas



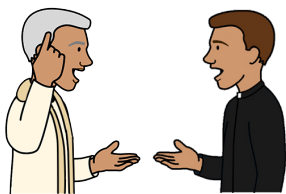
- keep an open mind to different ideas.

We will work together

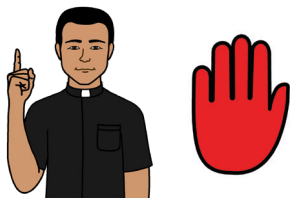


We want all Catholic people to work together.



We will make a plan to help people

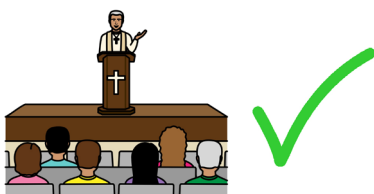
- work together to make the Church safe

We want to train Church leaders to do a better job.

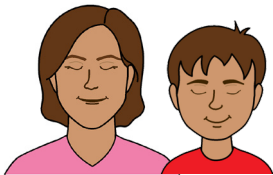


We will

We want women to be leaders at all levels of the Church.

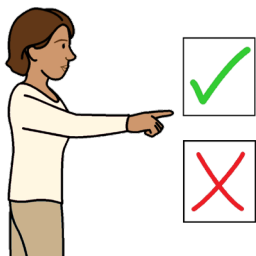


We will
