This book is written by the Plenary Council.




This book is about how we will make the Church more **joyful**.

We will plan ways for different people in the Church to work together.


For example

• help Churches to do good things




- find ways for Churches to share information and help each other

 include everyone. For example, people in the LGBQTI community.







We will make a national faith hub.




A national faith hub is a place where adults go to learn about God and the Catholic faith.

• help victims.


Victims are the people who were abused.

We will


 see how money is spread between Churches at the moment

 see if we can do jobs in a different way that costs less money.






